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Initial Community Opinion Survey Results & Analysis

March 2021

The first Ottershaw Neighbourhood Forum Community Opinion Survey received a very good response (c400) across a wide section of the village, although it was noted that the majority of respondents were in the age bracket of 40+. This has highlighted that more work needs to be done to engage the younger population of our Neighbourhood Area.

We will be using the analysis resulting from the survey responses as a key element to inform our Ottershaw Vision for the Future and have identified Key Areas of Focus to summarise the most significant survey outcomes.

You told us that you want Ottershaw to maintain its 'village feel' and whilst future housing growth is inevitable, transport infrastructure and community services must be scaled and improved accordingly.

You also told us that a key priority is maintaining and improving access to our green spaces and preserving areas of wildlife and natural habitat.

Traffic congestion, heavy vehicle traffic, speeding, 'rat runs' and parking issues with their associated safety impacts were also areas of significant concern and we hope we can put forward some sensible suggestions to minimise the impact of these problems on our residents.

Our next challenge is to formulate policies and solution options incorporating these important views, whilst working within the guidelines of the Local Development Framework and Runnymede Borough Council's 2030 Local Plan.

We look forward to working with the community to create a viable plan for the future of our village, that will enhance the village that we know and love, whilst securing its future and making way for the next generation to enjoy what we have always appreciated.

• A high proportion of responders felt that medical and school facilities would need to be scaled to meet increasing demand in the short term. Some responders felt that: • On street car parking was poorly configured for road layout in and around the village. The village car park needed better controls. • Medical and school facilities were major sources of congestion /pedestrian safety. • The existing amenities and facilities were currently adequate. **Housing Development** • The majority of responders were content with development providing there was a similar uplift to infrastructure, amenities and facilities. Nearly all responders felt that all aspects of new developments must blend in with the character of the village. Responders showed a preference for privately owned housing and elderly care accommodation. A small number of responders were against any significant future developments. Hospitality/Retail The addition of café/coffee shop(s) with outdoor seating as a daytime social gathering spot was requested by over a third of responders. Many responders felt that a mix of additional retail (bakery/butcher) would be a good addition to the village. A small proportion of responders felt that our retail was adequate. Crime/ASB Many responders expressed a concern for maintaining or ensuring a safe village environment.

Many responders were concerned about the amount of ASB, littering and petty crime in the village. CCTV and policing were raised by responders as services which could be used to mitigate some of this.

Although the responses showed a heavy bias towards the 40+ age group, the results of over and under 40s were markedly similar in nearly all cases.

Atmosphere, sense of community, rural feel and friendly nature of the village were felt by many responders to be important aspects to

Nearly two thirds of responders felt existing recreational facilities /conveniences etc were of insufficient quality and /or inadequate

Most responders felt that the village should not have any businesses, commercial premises or industry which required heavy traffic or

A number of responders felt the appearance of the village should be improved to provide a more characterful look.

• There was significant support from responders for ensuring the wildlife and ecology of the area was preserved and managed.

A very high proportion of responders felt that access to local open spaces/footpaths was very important to them.


Some responders felt that local bus services were insufficient in frequency and destinations.




2. How long have you lived in the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?






3. How long have you worked in the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?




4a. What do you like about the village / Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?






4b. Is there anything else you like about the village / Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?






5. What do you dislike about the village / Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?




5b. Is there anything else you dislike about the village / Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?






6. What's your employment status?






7a. Looking to the future - what's important to you about the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?






7b. Looking to the future – what else is important to you about the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?






8. What type of new shops, cafes/restaurants and other amenities would you like to see in the village?






9. What other facilities would you like to see in the village? (eg public conveniences, baby changing etc.)






10. What type of business would you NOT like to see in the village?






11a/b. What measures would you consider to improve safety in the village / Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?






12. What is your primary mode of transport?






13. What type of accommodation do you feel the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area lacks?






14a. How important is it that new housing and business developments in the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area are sympathetic to the following:

A strong feeling that all aspects of development must accord with the character of the village






14b. Anything else new housing and business developments in the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area should be sympathetic to?





15. Do you participate in any of the following in the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area?







16. Are there any sports, leisure, culture or social facilities in the Ottershaw Neighbourhood Area that could be added or improved?
